BOARD MEETING MINUTES

President's Update

Jay opened the meeting by announcing that the Coaches Committee has secured Mike Levine, a Chicago Hawks and HCHC alum, as our new Goalie Coach and Assistant Coach for both JV and Varsity. Mike, a lifelong goalie, currently works as an analyst at Morningstar and leads the goalie station for the Chicago Hawks. He is eager to play an active role in our recruiting efforts.

- Pros: Quick, accurate analytics, strong recruiting tool •
- ٠ Cons: ROI on player development uncertain
- Board agreed to explore a demo before making a final decision.

Social Media & Recruitment

Kelly met with Ashani Gupta, who will return as photographer and assist with social media.

- Ashani will upload all photos to a shared drive. She asked that all of her photos used on our social media be marked with her personalized tag Compensation: \$500/season
- Kelly will initiate another social media campaign to recruit marketing interns and grow followers. Players will be asked to share posts.
- Intern interviews ongoing, with the goal of securing the "social media team" by early September.
- Media Day will be planned for fall (after uniforms arrive), with an early shoot for seniors to build hype.
- Kelly suggested HCHC participate in the HCHS Activities Fair. She will follow up with Sally Phillips.
