2025 City DIBS

2026 City Rules

- Brandon Schreiner to update the City League Rules:
 - Add tie breaker information (games and placement).
 - o More strict rules on pitch count during tournament.
 - Add flexibility wording that the board may change pitching restrictions based on make up games or other considerations.
 - Allow USSSA and BBCOR bats
 - Yes, open to all leagues
 - BBCOR for Babe Ruth, not regular City League
- Brad Pochinski to lead the City Tournament Committee
 - o Kyle Sabatke, Ryan Talbert, and Brandon Schreiner to help.

Travel League Items

2026 Travel League Registration

- Offers were sent out to those who made teams. We have enough players to support 8U-14U.
 - o 10U is only at (9) players right now, so we will need to try to recruit a few extra over the off-season.

2026 Tournaments

- Tournament dates were chosen:
 - July 10-12th for the 10U, 12U, 14U
 - o July 24-26th for the 9U, 11U, 13U
- Do we want to increase the registration fee from \$375 to \$450?
 - MYB Board agrees to update team entry fees to \$450.
- When do we want to post these and through what service?
 - o Crossbar does tournaments and would make tracking and signup easy.
 - Brad Pochinski and Brandon Schreiner to setup signup through Crossbar and make sure to advertise only B-Teams

Travel League Rules

- Brandon Schreiner to make the below updates to the travel league tournament rules:
 - Change to dropped third strike at 11U+
 - USSSA bats allow any drop
 - o When should time start?
 - Time should start at the umpire's discretion.
 - Additional attire rules for pitchers
 - No jewelry, white arm sleeve, or anything to distract the batter.
 - Verbiage around who gets the awards
 - If the player played or was injured, but supporting the team at the games, they get an award.
