### 2025 & 2026 Raffle

- 2025 Raffle
  - All cash prizes are sent out and received by the winners.
  - o All gun or physical prizes have been claimed at Charlie's Hardware.
  - o The invoice to Charlie's has been paid in full.
  - o MYB is keeping the string trimmer prize that wasn't taken.
  - o Jerrod Gould to look into leaf blower.
    - Ideally this could be a battery Milwaukee tool set so we can get some more battery equipment.
- 2025 Raffle Remaining
  - We have (9) guns (\$4,500 value) that Jim Henaman will be auctioning throughout the winter/spring.
  - We cleared roughly \$22K and will receive an additional \$5-7K most likely on the auctions.
  - Jerrod Gould has worked with Charlie's to develop a Standard Operating Procedure for all future years.
     We will no longer be responsible for any excess inventory and all guns will be ordered the moment the winner chooses their prize option.
- 2026 raffle license is acquired.
