Sportsmanship

Teamwork

Players should be team players and get along with and respect their teammates.

Parents

Parents should be positive role models and show good sportsmanship. They should also support their children's desire to play and allow them to establish their own goals.

Officials

Players should trust the judgment and integrity of the referees and coaches. They should not lash out at officials, no matter what the call is.

Fighting

Fighting is not tolerated and will result in disciplinary action.

Substance Abuse

Players, coaches, and officials should not drink, smoke, chew tobacco, or use illegal substances at any team function.
