As a softball athlete, I understand that I must follow these rules to stay in good standing:

- Respect the game, play fairly, and follow the rules and regulations
- Show respect for authority to the officials of the game, the coaches of the game, and the league representatives.
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship before, during, and after the game
- Help parents and fans understand the league philosophy so they can watch and enjoy the teams play the game.
- Be courteous to opposing teams and treat all players and coaches with respect on and off the field.
- Support the team. Do not speak or use social media negatively towards other players, coaches, opposing teams and/or umpires. Zero tolerance for social media posts or text messages that are negative and directed towards teammates.
- Be modest when successful and be gracious in defeat.
- Respect the privilege of the use of public facilities. Always help with equipment and in keeping the field/dugout/surrounding area clean.
- Refrain from the use of bad language and from the use of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products.
- If a player does not, cannot or will not comply with the guidelines of the above stated contract consequences for violating the code of conduct will be determined by the board of directors and could lead up to being asked to no longer participate in the softball association.
- Failure to sign & return does not exempt me from any of these conditions or being subject to disciplinary action.
