

OPRF Huskies Hockey Game Uniform Policy

All OPRF rostered hockey players, including dual-rostered players, must adhere to the following uniform and gear requirements for games, scrimmages, and tournaments:

OPRF Hockey Club-Issued Items (Fee per item apply):

- Jerseys: Navy, Orange, White, Gray
- Helmet Stickers: OPRF logos and numbers
- Shell: Navy with OPRF logo
- Socks: Navy, Orange, White, Gray
- Gloves: OPRF logo gloves
- Bags: OPRF logo bag

Player-Provided Items:

- Navy helmet
- Full protective gear, including:
 - Mouth guard
 - Neck guard
 - Athletic cup

This policy ensures consistency and safety across all team activities. Any questions or disputes will be resolved by the current club president.

Number Selection Process

- Players must select a hockey number when registering for an OPRF Hockey season (fall/winter or spring).
- Numbers are assigned in the following order of priority:
 - Returning players with a club-issued number from the previous fall/winter OPRF Hockey season.
 - New fall players who wish to keep their number from the previous OPRF Hockey spring season.
 - New players to OPRF Hockey in fall or spring based on registration order.

General Guidelines:

- Older classes (Juniors/Seniors) or higher teams (Varsity) do not receive priority for number selection.
- Players from the previous fall/winter OPRF Hockey season who wish to change their number are treated as new players in the selection process.
- No duplicate numbers will be assigned within the same OPRF Hockey season across all teams.

Number Retention and Release:

- At the start of each fall OPRF Hockey season, during the registration process, all player numbers are reviewed and updated. If a player who previously had a number assigned leaves the club, even if they are still eligible to play based on their age or class, their number becomes available and can be reassigned to another player immediately during that registration period.
- Players who played in the most recent fall OPRF Hockey season, do not play the following spring season, but return the following fall/winter OPRF Hockey season, can retain their previously assigned number.
- Numbers may not be reserved or otherwise allocated to another player.

Retired Numbers:

- Any numbers retired by the club will not be reissued.

This policy ensures a fair and consistent process for assigning player numbers and unused numbers don't remain reserved for players no longer with the club. Any questions or disputes on numbers will be decided by the equipment manager.
