Tryout Illness/Injury/Attendance Policy

As of August 01, 2025



SALA has an Association-wide waiver policy and tryout injury/illness/attendance policy. The Stillwater Area Lacrosse Association board reserves the right to vote upon all tryout situations. In extraordinary situations the board reserves the right to make exceptions.

Tryout Scenario	SAHA Policy
Item 1: An existing SALA player elects to miss tryouts and is not sick or injured.	Players who elect not to attend ALL published tryout dates for their level will be placed on an appropriate "B" level team
Item 2: A player does not live in Stillwater School District 834 and their home organization has a program at the players age level that they do not wish to participate in.	The player must participate with their home residence organization unless waivers submitted, reviewed, and approved by the board a minimum of 30 days prior to tryouts.
Item 3: A player does not live in Stillwater School District 834 and their home organization does not have a program at the players age level.	The player may be accepted to compete with SALA for a 1 season term. They will be reevaluated based on their home association criteria for any additional seasons. The player will be applicable to all existing SALA player rules regarding tryout procedures, not including Item 6.
Item 4: A player moves into Stillwater School District 834 before tryouts but misses due to injury or illness.	Players without history will not be applicable to Item 6 and will be placed on an appropriate "B" level team.
Item 5: A player moves into Stillwater School District 834 after tryouts are closed.	Players without history will not be applicable to Item 6 and will be placed on an appropriate "B" level team.
Item 6: An existing SALA player is sick or injured and cannot tryout but will return post-tryouts.	The player will be placed on a team based upon the tryout scores of three like players provided by the previous year coaching staff and/or the boys and girls director. <i>*In extraordinary situations the board reserves the right to make exceptions.</i>
