Written report:

D10 Presidents meeting:

- D10 will be hosting contact clinics for associations looking to book them. They are 125 dollars plus the cost of the ice. Reach out to Casey Bernards at D10 for more info.
- U6/U8 coaching clinic is coming. Once completed this will be good for 4-5 years.
- Maximum of 5 rostered coaches allowed on a roster
 - Student coaches do NOT count as the 1 of 5, but will count as 1 of the 4 allowed on the bench during games
- Reminder to get your background checks submitted asap. Also inform coaches that this needs to be completed to avoid delays
- Minnesota Hockey Registrar Todd Elmer has stepped down. Becky Ewing the current D10 registrar has accepted that position, and will act as MN and D10 registrar for the upcoming season
- Head coaches will again be required to attend 1 of the 4 mandatory coaches meetings before the season starts. Dates and location to be posted on the D10 website
- Exhibition(scrimmage) refs will need to be booked in 60, 90, or 100 minute game times. If they are booked for a lesser amount(60) but the ice booked is for 90, they will leave the ice at the 60 minute mark

- On ice player gatherings will NOT be allowed this season. Player gatherings can take place off of the ice if they wish
- NEW this season- Student coaches will have to complete a class to be allowed on the team roster. This can be an association run class. USA hockey has created an agenda to follow (link attached below) OR we can create our own. We will need to sign off on each student coach, that they have completed the training before they can be added to the roster

USA HOCKEY STUDENT COACH AGENDA

- Sounds like at least 3 other associations(4 with us) are interested in declaring C bantams teams. D10 needs at least 5 to run their own league.
- For coaches interested in attending The Coaches Site Live coaching conference, discount pricing is available if we get 5 or more coaches to sign up. The normal cost is 250 per person, but TCS is offering a discounted rate of 200 if 5 or more ER coaches register.
 - Program details are: For two days, we will feature innovative presentations on player development, team tactics, culture building and program growth, all delivered by Minnesota's top hockey leaders like Luke Strand, Andy Ness & Enrico Blasi. We expect to host over 200 youth, high school and junior coaches from across the state
- The Elk River Park and Rec director reached out asking if we intend to have the outdoor rink at Lions Park again. I informed him that yes, we do intend on doing so.
- Reversible travel jerseys have been ordered, and hope to have them in a few weeks
- Sticker kits have been ordered. I did increase the amount from 600-650 to account for expected increase in registration numbers
- Reminder to all level directors to make sure you have coaches lined up to run pre tryout sessions, as well as evaluators for each session of tryouts.
- My inbox has been flooded with waiver requests of players wanting to waive in. Sounds like the u15 and u12 Princeton girls are good to go. 5- u15s, and 3-4 u12s coming from Princeton. 3 more u15's from Becker Big Lake.
- I have reached out to Amy Manson from the Positive Coaching Alliance to start the process of booking our sessions for the upcoming season. She got back to me right away, and they need us to pay the invoice for this season, before they can open up the ability to register. As soon as the registration link becomes available, I will work on dates etc.

- With the influx of new players this season, I intend to host a New family orientation meeting on September 8th at 6 pm location TBD. This would be open to ALL families in our program to help them understand things like our tryout process, team formations, volunteer and fundraising obligations, etc. I would like to have all level directors in attendance to help answer questions as well as Chris Rustad, Jennifer Dahlseid, Michelle Brandt, and any other board members who feel they can help answer questions for new families.

Currently only have 2 goalies at this age group and one is a moveup from U8s. Both U12s and U15s we have waived in girls from Princeton/BBL. There are three girls at U12s and 10 girls at U15s (3 of them played here last year). We are looking good for coaches at all three levels and have brought in more females this year to help coach.
