## **HOCKEY GUIDE 2024-2025**

## TEAM STRUCTURE

For the 2024-2025 season, all players will be grouped based on their birth year.

## TRYOUTS AND GENERAL DISCLOSURES:

- In order to be eligible to participate in the AAHL tryouts, a player must complete the online registration. All payments are made online, including the non-refundable tryout fee. NO CASH OR CHECK PAYMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- Every player must have current medical insurance to participate. Player parent(s)/guardian(s) are responsible in making sure that this item is covered prior to tryouts and/or any team participation.
- At least two tryout sessions (in most cases) will be provided for each division.
- All tryout fees are non-refundable. Refunds are not issued for missed sessions, declining a team offer, or for not being chosen for a team.
- Any earned credits from the previous season cannot be used for the tryout fee or commitment fee. Once teams are established any credits will be applied to the remaining season fee balance.



## **Team Evaluations:**

AAHL teams are selected based on a competitive criteria of AA, A, and B. The evaluation of players is necessary for the selection of teams. Players and families are bound by the results of these evaluations. Should you feel an appeal is necessary, you must bring your request to the AAHL Board of Directors for consideration.

## **Playing “Up” Policy:**

The AAHL philosophy of player development is that it is usually best for all players to play within their respective age group. However, in special circumstances a player may benefit from participating in a higher age group. Requests to play “up” must be in writing to the AAHL Board of Directors before tryouts of the upcoming season. Players are only permitted to tryout one (1) birth year higher (example – a 2<sup>nd</sup> year squirt could tryout for peewee, but a 1<sup>st</sup> year squirt is ineligible to tryout for peewee). A player that wishes to move upward in age classification, must score in the top 1/3 of all player’s tryout evaluation scores at the higher age classification to be moved up. **8U/Mite players are not eligible to play “up” by PAHL & Mid-Am rules. They must play at the 8U level.**

The AAHL Board of directors may, at its discretion, move players upward in age classification in order to achieve a balanced team population. Such Board decisions will be made in conjunction with and on the recommendation of coaches, with parent’s approval.

## **USA Hockey Registration:**

Online registration with USA Hockey is required. The USA Hockey registration fee is not included in the yearly dues for AAHL.

## **Medical / Liability Release Statement:**

If your child is injured during a USA Hockey, PAHL, PIHL, or Amateur Armstrong Hockey League (AAHL) sponsored event, you give permission to the person(s) in charge to seek medical attention. Upon entering events sponsored by USA Hockey or its member districts, you agree to abide by the rules of USA Hockey, PAHL, PIHL, and AAHL. You understand that participation in the sport of ice hockey constitutes risk of injury. You voluntarily and knowingly recognize, accept, and assume this risk and release USA Hockey and the AAHL, its affiliates, their sponsors, event organizers, coaches and officials from any liability therefore.

## **Uniforms:**

Arrows player uniforms consist of home/away jerseys, socks, and a shell. Each player will be required and responsible for the purchase and care of their Arrows uniform. Costs associated with their uniform are not included in the season fee. National Bound (14U/16U/18U and 19U Girls) Teams are required to wear navy helmets and gloves.

## **Equipment disclosure:**

All players must be equipped with the following: hockey skates, approved helmet with full face guard, mouth guard, throat protector, elbow pads, hockey gloves, chest protector, groin cup, padded hockey pants, shin guards, neck guard and a regulation hockey stick. USA Hockey Rule 304, regarding "Equipment" must be followed. Costs associated with hockey equipment are not included in the season fee and are the player/parent responsibility.

## Player Numbers:

- All players beginning at the age of 7 in 8U/ADM through 19U will be eligible to lock their player numbers for their continuous AAHL career.
- All players will be able to lock in their number; provided there is not another player with a birth year directly above or below, that has previously locked in the chosen number.
- 8U/ADM players that are ages 5 and 6 will choose numbers; however, they will not be locked in until they reach the age of 7.

**Example: If a player is 6 and a new player enters the league that is 8, both players will be allowed to use the number during 8U/ADM. This ensures the 8-year-old player to be able to lock that number for use in 10U.**

- In the instance that a player leaves the league, the player's number will be released and available for use and will not be held upon the possibility of return.

## Injury Exemption:

If a player becomes injured during the season and is not medically able to participate for more than 6 weeks, contact the treasurer to complete an injury exemption form to seek a reduction in season dues prorated to the length of the playing absence. Documentation from the doctor will be required and attendance requirements during the injury are up to the coaching staff.

## Release for "Use of Likeness":

By completion of the online registration, and/or appearing on a USA Hockey Roster for an AAHL registered team, all individuals (players, parents, guardians) consent to the use or publication of their image or likeness as part of any and all visual, audio, and/or video production, now or in the future, either produced by the AAHL or sanctioned by the AAHL, without requiring consent or compensation, and without protest. The AAHL has the authority to produce - or authorize production of - the name, image, and/or likeness of all (players, coaches, parents, guardians) for use on websites, social media networks, publications, and similar media at the sole discretion of the AAHL.

## Tournaments:

If the team participates in any tournaments, that team is responsible for collecting the fee(s) to cover the costs of those tournaments. *Exceptions are the National Bound (14U/16U/18U and 19U Girls) Teams in which these fees are included in the season fees.*

## Payments:

At the time of registration, the option to pay in full or make payments will be available. All payments will be made online through the AAHL website. **NO CASH OR CHECK PAYMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** The Commitment Fee will go towards the total season dues. If AAHL is charged a NSF fee for any player, that player is responsible to make that payment and also to pay any NSF fees charged to AAHL.

To ensure the financial stability of the Armstrong Amateur Hockey League (AAHL), if your account becomes delinquent according to the terms of this agreement, you agree that AAHL may commence proceedings before a District Justice or Magistrate to collect the unpaid amount and obtain a judgement for such amount plus interest and costs, and execute on such judgement by all lawful means.



## **Commitment Fee:**

The non-refundable \$400.00 (\$100 for 8U/Mites) Commitment Fee will be automatically charged to your account via credit card or bank account (ACH) once tryouts are complete and you have accepted a position on the team. If the player declines his placement within the posted timeframe, there will be no further financial obligation to AAHL. When a player accepts a position on a team by not declining in the timeframe outlined at time of team posting, you are obligated to pay the Commitment Fee, which will be applied towards your season fees. All payments are non-refundable.

If a player decides to resign from AAHL after having accepted a position, it is the responsibility of that player or that player's parents to notify both an Executive Officer of AAHL and either the Manager or Coach of that player's team. The notification to the Executive Officer must be in writing. All payments made are non-refundable. After August 1<sup>st</sup>, all players are required to pay their entire Season Fees prior to the AAHL issuing a release to play for another association.

## **Volunteer Responsibilities:**

AAHL is able to offer reasonable fees through the voluntary efforts of its members. We depend upon the families in the organization to participate in the running of the Belmont kitchen. If you do not wish to work in the kitchen, a buy-out is available at \$240/ player per team (\$60.00 per shift). In the event of a NO-SHOW for your shift, your account will be billed \$75.00/shift.

## **FUNDRAISING OPPORTUNITIES**

Throughout the season parents are offered the opportunities to decrease their hockey season costs. Some opportunities are league wide while others are available through individual teams.

Fundraisers/Fundraising: The league may choose to have one mandatory fundraiser during the season to ensure that adequate operating funds are available. The opportunity for additional individual fundraising credit to offset individual player fees will also be available. All fundraising needs to be approved by the AAHL Fundraiser Coordinator.

## **TRYOUTS**

The Armstrong Arrows tryouts will take place at The Belmont Complex in Kittanning, Pennsylvania.

### **\*\*\*TRYOUTS ARE CLOSED TO SPECTATORS\*\*\***

Tryouts are closed to all spectators at all age levels except 8U. A parent or guardian is permitted to assist their player with equipment at the 10U and 12U age group, but must leave the Belmont Complex prior to their player's tryout beginning.

## **Tryout Registration:**

- Our registration system is provided by AAHL Website/Crossbar Platform. You must have an ID (email address) and password to access our registration system. If you are a returning player, you will need to retrieve your ID and password from last year. If you are new to the Arrows, you may need to create a new ID and password.

- Obtain a 2024-2025 USA Hockey number after April 1<sup>st</sup> at: [www.usahockeyregistration.com](http://www.usahockeyregistration.com). With your USAH number, go to <https://www.armstrongarrows.com/> and click on the Program Tab along the top of the menu bar and select the program that you are registering for, then follow the instructions for registration. All players will pay by credit card or ACH (bank account) withdrawal for tryouts. All players must register via the website – all payments must be made prior to taking the ice on the first night of tryouts.

## Tryout Registration Fees:

***All prior Season balances must be paid in full before a player may be permitted to tryout***

- A non-refundable \$150.00 tryout registration fee (\$100.00 prior to March 15<sup>th</sup>) paid online prior to first day of tryouts.

## Tryout Absence:

If a player is going to miss all or part of tryouts, due to injury or illness, the player must still register and pay the tryout fee. The tryout team will make every effort to place the player on a team with like skilled players.

## First Day of Tryouts:

- Must have registered online and paid tryout registration fee prior to first day of tryouts. Tryout registration fee is non-refundable.
- **Players should arrive at the rink 60 minutes prior to each session and check in at the registration table - please bring:**
- TWO jerseys to every session - **one dark and one white.** These jerseys should be unmarked. No names and no emblems of PAHL, PIHL, or AAA teams are permitted at tryouts. Please also remove identifying pants shells and socks for tryouts.
- Full USA Hockey equipment including neck guard and mouthpiece.
- After the first session please check the AAHL website to confirm your next tryout time.

## After Tryouts:

- Tryout numbers of the players that made a team will be posted on the AAHL Website.
- If your player is offered a position on an AAHL team, you will have the established deadline to accept or reject the position.
- If a position is offered and you choose to decline the position before the established deadline, there will be no further financial obligation to AAHL. A response will be sent back confirming your decline.
- If you do not respond within the established deadline, your player is deemed as accepting a position on the team. The non-refundable commitment fee will be charged, which will be applied toward your player's season fees.
- An offer email will be provided to set up payment options for the season. You will be able to pay in full or use our monthly payment plan for the season via credit card or bank deposit (ACH). Monthly payment plan will begin on June 1<sup>st</sup>.
