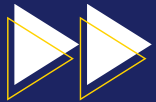

What costs can we expect?

- Registration: about \$500 or less
- Zorts player card: \$10
- AAU Membership: \$20
- Travel expenses for each tournament. We will have several out of state tournaments that will require a hotel stay but we will continue to look for more opportunities close to home.

Where will we travel?

- Tournaments in the Midwest - Primarily Ohio, Wisconsin and Michigan.

How many teams will there be and what ages?

- Tryouts are open to athletes born between 2009 & 2018. Final teams will be formed in age groups where we have commitment from both players and coaches.

Will teams be co-ed?

- We hope to be able to have at least one girls team, however we will not have that option at all age levels. Some teams will be co-ed.

When does the season start and end? How often will practices be?

- Practices will start in February. Plan on 1-2 practices per week.
- First tournaments are planned to be in April or May. We will not have a final schedule until around February 2026. The last tournament of the season is tentatively planned for the end of July.

How will playing time be handled?

- This is a competitive program, and equal playing time is not guaranteed. All athletes will develop through structured, focused practices, while game-time decisions will be made at the coach's discretion to keep the team competitive.
