 - 6 week timeframe (break over spring break of March 23-30th).
 - Sessions to occur week of 3/10, 3/17, 3/31, 4/7, 4/14, 4/21
- ★ Costs
 - Total ice cost of \$7,560 this year
 - Last season we estimated about \$7k
 - Fees rec'd in 2024 Approximately \$11,000 (not sure with total # of goalies)
- ★ Last years fees and max #'s
 - Mites \$90 w/ max of 48 (\$2,070 2024 fees @ \$90)
 - 2024 = 23 signups (included 3 HIP)
 - 2023 = 33 signups
 - Squirt \$120 w/ max of 28 skaters (\$3,360 2024 fees @ \$120)
 - **2024 = 29**
 - 2023 = 30 signups
 - PeeWee & Bantam \$120 w/ max of 26 skaters
 - 2024 PW 28 (5 goalies) / Bantam = 24 (\$6,240)
 - 2023 PW = 25 / 2023 Bantam = 26
 - Recommend caps on registration 26 @ Squirt and 24 @ PW & Bantam (Goalies were nominal charge of maybe \$10)
