

Dual Roster and Player Up Request Form

Dual Roster - You are requesting permission for your child to play on two Pinedale Glaciers Hockey teams for the upcoming hockey season.

Playing Up - Younger players move up to the next division for the upcoming hockey season.

The Board does not promote dual rostering players or moving players up except for special circumstances. The final decision will be at the discretion of the board with input from division coaches and based on PHA need.

Before requesting to dual roster or moving your child up to the next level, please consider your child's maturity, size, coordination, muscular development, attitude, and social development in comparison to the team members of the older team.

RULES:

- ***All requests must be made within the first three weeks of practice.***
- ***Up to coach's discretion, players MAY have to attend practices for both teams for at least 2 consecutive practices so coaches and the player can evaluate the following: skills, size, coordination, and player safety.***

Procedure for Dual Roster and Playing up

1. Parents fill out the Parent Portion of the Dual Roster or Playing Up Form.
2. Email it to PHA - president@pinedaleglaciers.org
3. PHA will email it to coaches involved.
4. Coaches will fill out paperwork, email it to PHA.
5. PHA will notify parents of decision.
