2026 YOUTH Boys and YOUTH Girls Player Registration Information

Please read the following PRIOR to beginning the registration process:

<u>USA Lacrosse Membership:</u> An annual USA Lacrosse Membership is required to participate. There is an annual non-refundable fee payable to USA Lacrosse for this membership.

A USA Lacrosse membership valid through June 15, 2026 will be required PRIOR to REGISTRATION for ALL players. In addition, AGE VERIFICATION is now required for membership.

You must register with USA Lacrosse prior to completing player registration. To obtain a new USA Lacrosse Membership or renew a USA Lacrosse Membership, please follow these steps:

- IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A CURRENT USA LACROSSE MEMBERSHIP: CLICK HERE to go to USA Lacrosse Registration and register your player(s). Be sure to PRINT and SAVE their confirmation code(s). Remember to register EACH of your players with US Lacrosse. Each player must have their own unique USA Lacrosse confirmation number.

- TO RENEW A USA LACROSSE MEMBERSHIP: CLICK HERE and log into USA Lacrosse with the email address used last season.
 - USA Lacrosse will ask if you are registering your son or daughter as a Player, Coach or Official. Select: PLAYER
 - USA Lacrosse will ask to designate the Primary Club/Program
 - Select **WISCONSIN** in the first drop down box for the state
 - Enter **WAUKESHA** in the search box.
 - Select: Waukesha Youth Lacrosse Club

Player Fee (YOUTH Players): Continued

Credit Card Payments: You may choose to pay your player's fee by credit card in full at time of registration or select a four installment payment plan.

Check/Cash Payments: Check/cash payments must be arranged with a program director and payment made prior to registration.

2026 Season Player fees must be paid PRIOR to participation in practices and/or games for the 2026 Season.

Player Refunds:

- If a refund is requested before the season, a refund less a \$75 fee will be given.
- If a refund is requested after the season starts, a pro-rated refund will be given.

All refunds are at the discretion of the Waukesha Lacrosse Club Board.

Refund requests must be made in writing and received by the Program Director.

ALL refund requests are to be directed to the WLC Treasurer.

2026 Volunteer Fee:

The Waukesha Lacrosse Club, Inc. is a non-profit organization which is run by Volunteers.

A \$200.00/Player or \$500/Family Maximum Volunteer Fee will be charged to each family for the 2026 season.

- Player 1: \$200 Oldest Player (Must fulfill the number of credits for this player's team)
- Player 2: \$200 Youngest Player (Must fulfill the number of credits for this player's team)
- Player 3: \$100 Remaining Players (Credits obligations are fulfilled for Players 1 & 2.)

A **separate** check dated **June 1, 2026** and made payable to WLC is required at the time of registration and prior to your player's participation in any practices or games.

If volunteer obligations are fulfilled for the 2026 Season, your check is destroyed. If volunteer obligations are NOT fulfilled for the 2026 Season, your check is cashed at the end of the season.

Required Equipment:

Youth Girls: Goggles, girls lacrosse stick -shaft and head, mouth guard, tennis shoes (for indoor practice), cleats (for outdoor practice & games) and practice jersey (available for purchase during registration).

Youth Boys: Helmet, shoulder pads, elbow pads, gloves, boys lacrosse stick -shaft and head, mouth guard, a protective cup, tennis shoes (for indoor practice), cleats (for outdoor practice & games), practice jersey (available for purchase during registration) and BLACK shorts/sweatpants/thermal leggings (more information will be communicated at the Parent/Player Meeting in January.)

Team provided uniforms and equipment:

Each player will receive a uniform.

The team issued items will be signed out to each individual player. All items are required to be returned in good condition on the date specified by the program director or other designated person.

A **separate** \$75.00/player check dated **June 1, 2026** and made payable to WLC is required at the time of registration and prior to your player's participation in any practices or games.

This check will be cashed if the uniform is not returned or damaged. Replacement costs are based upon manufactured pricing and minimum order requirements.

Returned/Non-Sufficient Funds Fee:

A returned check/non-sufficient funds fee of \$35 will be charged to the player's parent(s)/guardian(s) for any payment returned for non-sufficient funds or due to a stop payment. All outstanding balances are due prior to further participation.
