- 4. Badger Development League (BDL):
- This league is managed out of Waunakee and consists of teams from communities throughout South Central Wisconsin and into the Fox Valley
- o The league consists of six (6) tournament weekends from December to March
- Schedule:
- Play either Saturday or Sunday.
- 3rd grade plays 2 games per day
- 4th-5th plays 3 games per day
- Timeline for BDL weekend schedules release
- Girls League weekend schedule will be released by October 15, 2025.
- Boys League weekend schedule will be released by November 1, 2025.
- This will only indicate which day and weekend your team will be playing.
- BDL Time Schedules

- The game times schedule will be released about 3-7 days prior to the event.
- Girls typically start the last weekend of November and end mid February
- Boys typically start the first weekend of December and finish the end of February
- 5. Skill Assessments for 3rd through 5th Grade
- 3rd & 4th graders will be evaluated during practice 2-3 weeks into the season. These
 evaluations will be done by members of the MHBC Board, with coaches' input.
- 5th graders will be assessed by an outside, third party. MHBC board members will facilitate the evaluation sessions.
- o We need rosters submitted to leagues by mid-October.
- Assessments for 5th graders will be held on 9/14/25 and 9/21/25 from 4:45 to 5:45 PM in the High School. See schedule below.
- Please plan to attend both sessions
- Be there 15 minutes prior to time to get checked in
- Please wear a numbered uniform top for both dates (don't need to wear uniform bottoms)
- Wear same numbered top both dates
- 6. Teams and talent division
- 3rd-4th grades (Split evenly)
- 5th grade
- If only enough for TWO teams, they will be split evenly
- If enough for THREE teams, the top 16 to 20 kids will be split evenly and play in the BDL
 Badger league, the other 8 to 10 kids will play in the BDL Bucky Recreation league
- 7. The Board interviews candidates (both Parent & Non-Parent) for ALL grades

- We encourage non-parent coaches but typically have volunteer parent coaches for 3rd-5th Boys/Girls
- 8. Practice times TBD, please be patient as gym space is limited.
- o In general, practice schedules will be released in segments:
- Oct-Dec
- Xmas break
- Jan-Feb
- March
- o Schedules are not fixed throughout the season. Times and gyms may change.
- 9. Mount Horeb BDL Host Dates
- o Girls: December 6-7, 2025
- o Boys: January 24-25, 2026
- BDL doesn't guarantee all Mount Horeb teams will play in MH when we host
- Expectation is that parents will volunteer so we can continue to host

10. Weather

- If no school or let out early, No practice
- o If school is delayed, plan for practice unless told by coaches
- BDL tournaments host school will decide and communicate with coaches as soon as possible
- 11. Tournaments outside of league play.
- Through the assessments, we try to identify like-talent.

- The goal is to create a competitive environment against equal or better talent level that will push our players to grow and develop, and prepare them for high school.
- This prepares kids for high school.

- Recommendation:
- Each 3-5th grade team should aim for 20-30 games per season.
- MHBC will provide gym space to practice. Coaches/Parents need to take responsibility to find talent appropriate tournaments.
- If you don't know where to look or go... reach out to MHBC or other coaches.
- Cost of tournaments are covered by parents
- Coaches of these tournament teams has to be one of the BDL coaches

12. Troll Classic Tournament

- Dates March 21 and March 22, 2026
- We promote this as an A level tournament.
- One team (top ten A teams) per grade will represent Mount Horeb.
- Parents of tournament kids will be required to work a 3-4 hour admissions or concessions shift during this weekend.
- Girls play Saturday and volunteer Sunday.
- Boys play Sunday and volunteer Saturday.
- Please don't make your coaches fill in shifts.
- Keep these weekends open, it's fun and there is a lot of energy during this tournament.
