## Goalie Skills

BHA has agreed to approve the purchase of 2 sessions of a goalie skills clinic for the upcoming season. The Goalie skills clinic will be exclusive to BHA goalies from Squirts, Peewee, and Bantam levels only. The current goalie count is 8 for these levels. The Goalie skills program chosen is Stop It Goaltending in Woburn, MA. Details are below:

Goalie Skills Proposal Includes

- 1. Ice cost
- 2. One SIG director
- 3. Two staff shooters
- 4. Four goalies per hour

#### **Features**

- 1. Goaltending instruction at one of our development centers on **REAL ICE**.
- 2. A step by step curriculum for each lesson and session.
- 3. A video reference for each lesson and resource videos.
- 4. A schedule that starts and ends concurrent with the hockey season.
- 5. A one week break over the winter holidays.

(Week Nights): \$256 per lesson -\$2,048 per 8 Week Session.

In summary, there will be a 16 week curriculum where 1 of the 2 groups will go every other week.

Tony Caterino accepted the motion, then Dan Matarazzo seconded the motion. It was a unanimous vote of approval with the rest of the board members.
