- 1. Call to order @8:02pm by Wright.
- 2. Review and Approval of **April 2025** monthly meeting minutes Request to change Eric Albrecht from Attendee to Guest at April 2025 meeting. **Motion** made by Wright, seconded by Suihkonen. No further discussion, all in favor. Motion passed.
- 3. April Gambling Report May 28, 2025

**Motion** to approve the Gambling Report for **April 2025** made by Albrecht, Second by Kukowski. All in favor – No opposed. Motion passed.

**Motion** to approve a proposed budget for **June 2025** made by Suihkonen, Second by Lundquist. All in favor – No opposed. Motion passed.

Andrea Mahnke will become the Gambling Manager July 1st.

## 4. Old Business:

- a. Fundraising Macy Johnson volunteered to take over the apparel side of the fundraising committee
- b. HAHA Board representation at the District 11 annual meeting.

## 5. New Business:

- a. Discussion from Level Coordinators and board members about anticipated registration numbers at each level to plan for upcoming season tournaments and ice scheduling. No changes proposed for Bantam, peewee, or Mirage levels for the 25-26 season. An additional team will be added at the squirt level. For the 25-26 season, planning to have A, B1, B1, B2, B2 squirt teams.
- b. Discussion about Minnesota Hockey and District 11 request for associations to implement a Recruitment/Growth Coordinator position. Wright will get additional information about the position and it will be discussed further at the June meeting.
- c. Discussion about District 11 implementation of C Teams. The conversation resulted in no interest in Hermantown adding C teams for the 25-26 season.
- d. Registration Albrecht gave an overview of issues observed with registration in previous seasons and shared plans to make improvements for the 25-26 season. Planning is underway

for registration with all board members asked to obtain USA hockey registrations prior to the June meeting. Updates planned for the annual registration Family Packet and clean-up needed for the website. Discussion about the features available to the association through various youth sports software on the market. A comparison of strengths and weaknesses of both Sports Engine and Crossbar were presented. Discussion resulted in board members determining that a change to Crossbar would improve registration and user experience through the season for families. **Motion** to transition from Sports Engine to Crossbar made by Albrecht, seconded by Suihkonen. All in favor – No opposed. Motion passed.

- e. Discussion about the need for wetland permitting support as part of replacing outdoor rinks lost during the arena expansion project. **Motion** to approve \$1,500 in funds for GEI Consultants wetland services made by Fox, seconded by Wright. All in favor No opposed. Motion passed.
- f. Discussion about request for HAHA float in 2025 Summerfest Parade. Email to be sent to all association members seeking volunteers.
- g. Email sent to association members on May 2, 2025 seeking self-nominations for vacant Tournament Director board appointed position. Discussion on job duties and input from arena manager. **Motion** to appoint Adam Lilyquist as HAHA Tournament Director for 1 year term made by Wright, seconded by Pedisic. All in favor No opposed. Motion passed.
- A proposal to purchase new jerseys for Mirage teams was shared. Discussion about the need for newer jerseys at various levels and growth of the program. Motion to approve \$20,000 for a Mirage Jersey Order made by Albrecht, seconded by Fox. All in favor – No opposed. Motion passed.
- i. Discussion about in-arena camera technology available to organizations and the current cameras/streaming services at Hermantown Arena. The high school teams widely utilize the technology and there is an opportunity for youth teams and coaches to better incorporate video usage during their seasons to enhance player development. Camera's/streaming are the norm at arenas across the country and are currently used by association families. Discussion about a proposal received 5/28/25 for video services to be used by HAHA. Discussion about costs of various services and opportunities to lower the long term financial commitment through increased public viewing/subscriptions of streams from games played at Hermantown facilities. Motion to approve a 3-year, up to \$1,900/year commitment by HAHA for equipment installation and access to software with Spiideo made by Huttel, seconded by Kukowski. All in favor No opposed. Motion passed.

Tournament registration fees are higher than previous years and registration for tournaments tends to open earlier each year, costs hitting the association earlier than seen in previous seasons.

Discussion about Fund A Hawk administration and HAHA contributions to program. **Motion** to approve \$1,500 contribution to Fund A Hawk, with full 2025-2026 funding coming out of clothing sales, made by Suihkonen, seconded by Albrecht. All in favor – No opposed. Motion passed.

**Motion** to approve treasurer's report made by Albrecht, seconded by Clauson. All in favor – No opposed. Motion passed.

- 7. Player Development: Huttel: Discussion about filling vacant Player Development Sub-committee positions, plan to have more information to share at June meeting.
- 8. Level Coordinator Reports:

- b. Outdoor Ice: Fox Conrad presented a plan for rink maintenance over the summer and discussion around possible locations on the property to add outdoor rinks. Discussion about how to source materials and find volunteers to complete work.

- e. Girls U10-U12: Clauson Registering for tournaments. Shared insight on annual reconciliation between HAHA and PAHA for Mirage program expenses. HAHA tends to cover certain expenses while PAHA supplies the bulk of the ice time for the Mirage players. Generally results in a fair arrangement between the associations.
- f. Girls U6-U8: Gilbert Registering for tournaments
- g. BN: Kukowski Discussion about coaches for teams, Motion to approve HAHA payment for 3<sup>rd</sup> tournament for Bantam AA team due to no home tournament made by Albrecht, seconded by Huttel. All in favor No opposed. Motion passed.
- h. PW: Pedisic Tournament registration is going good. Morning skate setup for all peewee age players. Discussion about coaches for teams. Motion to approve HAHA payment for 3<sup>rd</sup> tournament for Peewee AA team due to no home tournament made by Wright, seconded by Kukowski. All in favor No opposed. Motion passed.
- i. SQ: Peterson Registering for tournaments. Motion to approve HAHA payment for 3<sup>rd</sup> tournament for Squirt A team due to no home tournament made by Suihkonen, seconded by Pedisic. All in favor No opposed. Motion passed.
