Legacy Lacrosse Bylaws

Article I: Organization Name and Purpose

Legacy Lacrosse LLC is a Southern Indiana-based lacrosse organization dedicated to growing the sport through accessible programming, high-quality player development, and community engagement. The organization serves youth and high school athletes and provides clinics, camps, travel teams, and training.

Article II: Membership Requirements

- All players, coaches, and staff participating in Legacy Lacrosse activities must maintain **current USA Lacrosse membership**.
- USA Lacrosse membership must be valid through the end of the playing season.
- Legacy Lacrosse will verify USA Lacrosse membership status pre-season and mid-season using the USA Lacrosse Roster Management Tool.
- No individual may participate in any Legacy Lacrosse activity without valid and verified USA Lacrosse membership.

Article III: Program Leadership Requirements

- At least one designated Program Leader within Legacy Lacrosse must maintain an active USA Lacrosse Program Leader membership.
- This ensures access to national best practices in compliance, safety, and coaching development.

Article IV: Safety and Risk Management

- Legacy Lacrosse abides by the Athlete Safety Guidelines established by USA Lacrosse, including:
 - Concussion protocols
 - SafeSport compliance
 - Weather and emergency procedures
- All staff are expected to maintain up-to-date First Aid/CPR knowledge.
- Event and practice safety plans will be developed and implemented for each Legacy Lacrosse event.

Article V: Coaching Requirements

• All coaches must:

Be active USA Lacrosse members

Complete a background check

Complete SafeSport training prior to working with minors

Follow Legacy Lacrosse's player development philosophy and curriculum

Article VI: Code of Conduct

All participants — players, coaches, parents, and staff — must adhere to:

USA Lacrosse's Code of Conduct

Legacy Lacrosse's standards of professionalism, respect, and sportsmanship

Violations may result in suspension or removal from Legacy Lacrosse programs at the discretion of the Executive Director.

Article VII: Insurance Compliance

 USA Lacrosse membership ensures coverage under USA Lacrosse's general liability and participant accident insurance programs.

• Legacy Lacrosse will request a Certificate of Insurance (COI) for each event, venue, or season.

 Insurance coverage is valid only when all rostered participants are verified USA Lacrosse members.

Article VIII: Amendments

These bylaws may be amended at any time by agreement of the Legacy Lacrosse Ownership Team. Amendments will be documented in writing and distributed to all stakeholders.
