Plunder the Paint Classic Bay Port Girls Basketball Tournament Rules

- 1. Guaranteed 3 games
- 2. Awards will be given for 1st and 2nd places
 - a. Limited to 12 players per team
- 3. Time
 - a. All grades: 2-18 minute halves
 - i. Running clock except for the final 2 minutes of each half
 - b. Three full timeouts per game
 - i. One additional timeout for each team in each overtime period
 - c. 5 minutes warmup between games
 - d. 3 minute halftime
 - e. Overtime
 - i. 3 minute overtime with clock stopping on each whistle.
 - ii. If still tied after second overtime, the 10 players on the floor will shoot 1 free throw each home team on the scoreboard will shoot first, guest will shoot second

4. Defense

- a. Grades 3-6: man to man only
 - i. 2nd violation will result in 2 points awarded to the opponent
- b. Grades 7-8: Any defense allowed

5. Pressing

- a. Grade 3: No pressing allowed
- b. Grade 4: Pressing allowed the last minute of each half and the last minute of overtime, man to man press only, no pressing if up by 15 or more points
- c. Grades 5-6: Pressing allowed the last 2 minutes of each half and the last 2 minutes of overtime, no pressing if up by 20 or more points
- d. Grades 7-8: anytime, no pressing if up by 20 or more points

6. Free Throws

- a. Grades 3-4: Will shoot from the 13' line, may jump over the line.
- b. Grade 5: Will shoot from the 15' line, may jump over the line.
- c. Grades 6-8: Will shoot from the 15' line, may not jump over the line.

7. Technical Fouls

- a. 1st technical foul will result in automatic 2 points and the ball to the opponent
- b. 2nd technical foul will result in automatic 2 points for the opponent and ejection from the game
- 8. Tie Breaker (if necessary)
 - a. Best Record
 - b. Head to Head
 - c. Points Allowed
 - d. Points Differential

9. Miscellaneous

- a. Any team cancelling their entry within 2 weeks of scheduled play will not be issued a refund.
- b. No All-Star or AAU teams allowed. Rosters must be made up of players from one school district.
- c. Players must have matching jerseys with numbers on the front and back.
- d. Teams must provide their own basketballs for warm ups. Referees will choose a ball from the teams playing to be used as the game ball.
- e. Teams must provide a scorekeeper.
- f. All other WIAA rules are in effect if not specifically listed above.
- g. No protests. The referees rulings are final.
- h. A full concession stand will be available. Please no carry ins. Remember, this is a fundraiser for our girls youth basketball program.
- i. The Tournament Director will make the final decision on all matters that are not covered above.
