## **8U MoTown Throwdown Tournament Rules – 2026**

- 1. <u>Game Duration</u>: All games will be 6 innings with a 15 run rule after 3 innings, 12 after 4 innings and 10 after 5 innings.
- 2. <u>Max Runs</u>: Maximum 5 runs allowed per inning, with exception in 6<sup>th</sup> inning. 8 runs will be allowed in the 6<sup>th</sup> inning.
- 3. <u>Team Roster</u>: No limit to number of players on team roster; awards will be limited to 15. All players can only be included on roster for the tournament. All players must be 8 or under as of August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025.
- 4. Cleats: Shoes with metal spikes are NOT allowed.
- 5. All players must play at least one inning in the field. The round robin batting order will be used. If an athlete is injured and misses their turn at bat, they can not return in that game (no out taken). Ten players with four outfielders on the grass will be used in the field. A game may be started or continued with a minimum of eight (8) players. Unlimited defensive substitution.
- 6. NO infield fly rule.
- 7. No bunting is allowed.
- 8. **NO stealing is allowed.** Runners may leave the base once the ball crosses the plate. Runners may advance one base per overthrow to any base on a batted ball in play.
- 9. **Pitching:** Pitching will be done by a spring-release pitching machine (Louisville Slugger Blue Flame). The pitching machine will be set up at approximately 35'.
  - a. Pitching Machine settings will be:
    - i. Pitch Height (3)
    - ii. Speed (4)
    - iii. Release Block (3)
  - b. Batting team coach releasing the pitch must ensure everyone is ready before starting the ball in play.
  - c. If the ball hits the coach or machine the play is dead. Any runners will return to the base they were at. Batter will get an additional pitch.
  - d. Batters will receive 5 pitches, unless they strike out swinging (3 swings and misses).
  - e. NO TEES WILL BE USED.
  - f. If after 5 pitches the batter has not hit the ball, she will be considered out. If the batter founds off the 5<sup>th</sup> pitch it will be considered a foul ball and they will get another pitch from the machine. If the batter hits a foul ball on the 3<sup>rd</sup> swing or 5<sup>th</sup> pitch, it will not be considered a strikeout. The batter will get an additional pitch until either the ball is put in



- play, or the batter swings and misses (for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time). The batter must swing at all pitches after the 5<sup>th</sup> pitch.
- 10. <u>Team Roster Submission</u>: Final team roster must be turned into Tournament Director 30 minutes before 1<sup>st</sup> game. No changes will be made to roster after that time. Proof of age needs to be available should a question arise. It is the responsibility of the coach to provide this information should they be asked. Line-ups should be shared with opposing team 10 minutes before game time.
- 11. Home team is decided by a coin flip. Home team is official scorebook.
- 12. **Visiting team will control the scoreboard.** Remote is located within Concessions Stand. At the conclusion of the game, please return the remote to the Concessions stand for the next game.
- 13. Aside from the above exceptions, refer to most current <u>USA Softball Rule Book</u>.
- 14. Profanity or harassment by a team member, coach or fans toward an opposing team, umpire or official of the tournament will NOT be tolerated. This type of activity can lead to an ejection of said team member, coach or fan, without warning, by a tournament official or umpire.
- 15. The Tournament Director reserves the right to change any of the rules previously listed.
- 16. Placing tie breakers are as follows:
  - a. Head to head competition
  - b. Run differential (runs scored runs allowed, 10 runs per game max)
  - c. Runs allowed
  - d. Runs scored (teams will only be credited with a maximum of 10 runs more than they gave up for tiebreaker purposes)
  - e. Coin flip
