

LDMBA Code of Conduct

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Conduct within the spirit of this Code of Conduct is expected of players, assistant coaches, coaches, managers and parents/spectators.

The dignity and spirit of all people - players, parents, assistant coaches, coaches, conveners, managers, umpires and Board officials - is to be respected at all times. Violence of any nature will not be tolerated.

All those participating in the activities of LDMBA are to be treated fairly and equitably.

Profanity is prohibited at the ball diamonds.

This organization is comprised of volunteers and I will respect their efforts.

Public property and the property of others and LDMBA will be respected.

Any conduct that LDMBA deems unacceptable will be brought to the Board for review.

CODE FOR COACHES

I will give, to the best of my ability, the proper instruction of the fundamentals of baseball, teaching the game while offering constructive criticism, while maintaining a positive attitude.

I will set a good example for my players knowing that actions speak louder than words.

I will teach my players to respect the rules, officials, and their opponents, encouraging them to be good sports.

CODE FOR PLAYERS

I will play fairly and by the rules and in the spirit of the game and I will respect my opponents, coaches and teammates. I will never argue with an umpire. When a call is disputed, I will let the coach handle it.

CODE FOR PARENTS AND SPECTATORS

I will remember that young athletes play sport for everyone's enjoyment.

I will respect and honor the judgment of coaches and umpires. Knowing that mistakes are part of the game, I will not ridicule them for making them.
