Hockey season has officially started and it is important to remember that this is a marathon not a sprint. As most of us know, the teams you are on will see you more than your relatives for the next 6 months. That's part of why you'll hear everyone here say that we are like a family. You'll share meals, other parents will hold your baby while you tie skates and of course you'll disagree at times. As you sit down at night and do your backwards math, remember that the most important thing about the season is how the players feel. Is your player happy and growing? Are they getting everything out of the season that they are putting into it? Your players will endure struggles together as your team tries to find its groove or after a particularly hard loss. They will experience joy as they master new skills or have new experiences at tournaments. We, as parents, will learn to navigate the fact that those two extreme emotions can happen on the same day. A lot more than just hockey happens in these 6 months, on both sides of the glass. If your player isn't getting what they need for growth, have a conversation with your coaches (or if your player is old enough, encourage them to have the conversation) and bring ideas on what can be done. Everyone here is a volunteer and doing the best they can with what they have. I know not every situation this season is ideal and some groups are already struggling but it is important that everyone finds what they can do to help their player and the family.

Caren is certified by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association and a member of CT Academy of Audiology and the Academy of Doctors of Audiology. At the Hearing Improvement Center, they test your hearing, select and dispense the hearing instruments that best meet your needs, and provide support, counseling and service for the hearing devices. They are concerned about the person and make hearing solution recommendations to fit your lifestyle and personal needs.


