


# WHY MONITORING MATTERS

- "At USA Hockey, the locker room is more than just a place to change — it's where team culture begins. That's why we require responsible adult supervision at all times. Protecting our athletes' physical and emotional safety isn't optional; it's a standard we hold ourselves to, on and off the ice."
  - ❑ Protect athlete dignity
  - ❑ Prevent misconduct and bullying
  - ❑ Ensure privacy and boundaries
  - ❑ Build trust in your team and organization



# POLICY OVERVIEW

- **Key Rules to Know:**
-  **Two Deep Rule: Two screened adults present**
-  **Same-Gender Monitoring whenever possible**
-  **No cell phones or recording devices**
-  **Monitors must be SafeSport trained and background checked**



**CAUTION!**

# COMMON PITFALLS

- Unscreened adults in locker areas
- Only coaches as locker room monitors
- Locker room monitors not listed on rosters
- Misuse of phones or cameras
- Players in locker rooms before any adults
- Lack of gender consideration
- Incidents not properly documented or reported
- Locker room monitors outside of ear-shot and sight
- Mixed gender locker rooms with out proper locker room monitors and base layers



# YOUR ROLE

- Complete SafeSport training annually
- Complete your background screening
- Understand locker room monitor policies
- Monitor with discretion, professionalism, and respect
- Keep everyone safe in the locker room
- Get rostered as a locker room monitor
- Speak up and report concerns
- Make sure everyone knows and follows the rules
