

Boulder Hockey Club 2026 RoughRider Roundup Jamboree

General Information and Jamboree Rules/Format:

- 1. **Age Classification:** This is a USA Hockey sanctioned event for **Mite Beginner Level** or Mini Mite teams only (ages 8 & under house/recreational).
- 2. Location: Blue Sports Stable at Superior
- **3. Tournament Date:** Saturday, February 7, 2026.
- 4. Registration & Fees:
 - 4.1. Registration deadline is January 16, 2026.
 - 4.2. A minimum of 16 Mite Beginner level teams will be accepted.
 - 4.3. A maximum of 36 Mite Beginner level teams will be accepted.
 - 4.4. Additional teams may be accepted as approved by the tournament director based on ice availability.
 - 4.5. Entry fees are \$550 for each team. Admission is free for all spectators.
 - 4.6. To apply for the Jamboree a team must complete the online application and submit payment. Payment by credit card at time of registration is preferred, or you may mail a check payable to Boulder Hockey Club to:

- 4.7. Once a team is accepted into the Jamboree no refunds will be provided. Un-cashed checks will be returned and credit card charges will be credited to the account charged for any team that is not accepted.
- 4.8. All teams must provide a USA Hockey 1-T roster no later than <u>1/26/2026</u> so that teams can be confirmed for participation in the jamboree according to CAHA regulations.

5. General Jamboree Format and Rules:

- 5.1. All Beginner teams will play minimum four (maximum of 5) 30 minute cross ice games.
- 5.2. USA Hockey ADM rules regarding 8-Under will apply.
- 5.3. All players, coaches, and managers must be registered with USA Hockey for the current season to be eligible for Jamboree. This will be verified at check-in.
- 5.4. Boulder Hockey Club Tournament/Jamboree Directors/Committee will enforce the USA Hockey zero tolerance policy for spectators, parents, coaches and players. Anyone who violates these principles will be removed from the Jamboree.

- 5.5. Protests will not be allowed for any reason. The intent of this jamboree is to promote good sportsmanship and fun.
- 5.6. There are no uniform color requirements. We recommend bringing both home and away jerseys if available.

6. Check In

- 6.1. Each team is required to check in <u>at least 30 minutes</u> prior to their first game and show an approved USAH 1-T roster prior to participation. Team rosters must include all participating coaches, players and at least one manager. Only the manager is required to check in.
- 6.2. Each team must be ready to take the ice **5 minutes** prior to each scheduled game.

7. Locker Room Policy

- 7.1. Dressing area assignments will be posted in the rink lobby prior to each game.
- 7.2. All teams must follow the USA Hockey Safesport Locker Room Policy.
- 7.3. Each team should report to their assigned dressing areas 30 minutes prior to first game time and be ready to take the ice 5 minutes prior to game time.
- 7.4. Each team shall be out of their respective locker room within 20 minutes after their game.

8. Beginner Game Format

- 8.1. All games shall be cross ice and be 30 minutes long (includes warm-up).
- 8.2. Each team will have four or five skaters to a side, depending on total players per team, per game. Number of players is at the coaches' discretion, we recommend 4 unless both teams have more than 12 skaters.
- 8.3. No dressed goalies are allowed. Mini nets or intermediate nets will be used for all games.
- 8.4. The horn will sound every 2 minutes for line changes, with a running clock.
- 8.5. Scores will **not** be kept. There will not be any overtime periods or tie-breakers.
- 8.6. No referees will be provided. Games will be supervised by coaches (1 per team).
- 8.7. There will be a face off to start the game and after all goals.
- 8.8. Blue Game Pucks will be provided.
- 8.9. Only USA Hockey certified coaches and players are allowed on the ice/bench
- **9. Neck Guards** All players are required to wear neck guards.
- **10. Damage to Facilities** The Head Coach, or one of their assistants if they are not available, is totally responsible for the locker room. This responsibility CANNOT be delegated to a parent volunteer or any other individual that is not an assistant coach on the team. Should any player or team willfully damage any property in the facility, all costs for repair or replacement shall be paid by the team concerned. Arrangements for restitution shall be made immediately with the rink management. Any profanity or abusive behavior towards rink personnel will result in ejection from the rink and the jamboree.
- 11. Forfeits and Refusal to Play Any Team which enters a tournament and fails to appear on time for a scheduled Game or any Team (CAHA registered orotherwise) who fails to

provide a valid 1-T roster to the Tournament Director prior to the first game of the tournament will be subject to: 1) Forfeit all tournament Games as determined by the Tournament Director(s). 2) Pay for all expenses, including but not limited to Referee fees and ice costs for each forfeited Game. 3) Denied entry in any Colorado tournaments for the remainder of the season and in the case of a CAHA team, any approved travel permits will be rescinded.

- 12. The USAH Sanctioned Tournament Safe Sport Program Protocol will be adhered to.
- 13. Jamboree games will count towards your ADM game count for the 2024-25 season.
