Gambling Business (6:05-6:15 pm) CEO Phil Diskerud & Ashlee Howarth Gambling Mgr

- August was high as a result of the taxes being started, taxes are based off of tiers, we are now at a higher tier: We typically get about a month and a half at the lower tier
- August \$59K total: Stouts was not open for the state fair and McCarron's was out of AC for a few days, so lower this month
- Using a new vendor for etabs and electronic gaming as well: more interest in eTabs
- Bingo hall doing well
- Hill Murry bingo location opened up recently: Fox Hole,
 - Fox Hole (crooked pint basement): very busy opening weekend, turning people away, the rest not as busy
 - o Customers were new to bingo so might get, more people interested in bingo
 - Biggest difference is that it Serves alcohol and we do not so it's a different clientele
- Bar bingo occurs every Monday at McCarron's
- Is there still an option to do a hockey themed bingo, for folks not interested in purse bingo?
 - Will do one massive product bingo
- We need to build a closet for Bingo supplies (stouts was 14K, but likely would not cost this much)
- Letter sent to city council: to get more gambling businesses involved (limited to 3), should get a solid answer, but need permission to get on the meeting agenda to talk about the need and business want to for more businesses to be involved
- Bingo hall history: started w/football and baseball; turned over to RAYHA 32 years ago, when they could not make money

Finance Report- Jens Fredrickson

- No changes to expenses and revenues
- Last month recommended looking back at budget to see if we can put 80K of 105K of Employee Retention Credit into 6mo CD, w/potential yield of 5.2 AYP; (BMO #1 bank)
 - o Rates were better at 6 months
 - o If need the money before the 6 months, penalties are very low to withdraw early
 - Could look at tiering, where we always have money invested in a CD, but rates did not make sense at this point
 - o Will talk to our current bank [Premier] to see if they can BMO option
 - When will we do this? ASAP
- Motion to move forward with putting 80k in 6 month CD: Discussion > Motion > Passes

D2 Team Declarations - Vice President Scott

- Change in Squirts from B2 to B1, was relayed to D2
- Squirt: 21 C teams, 17 B2 teams, 15 B1 teams, 8 A teams
- 10U: B2 12 teams, B1 12 teams, A 4 teams
- Peewee: C 17 teams, B2 16 teams, B1 11 teams, A 9 teams, AA 3 teams
- 12U: B2 6 teams, B1 10 teams, A 5 teams
- Bantam: C 13 teams, B2 16 teams, B1 9 teams, A 6 teams, AA 6 teams
- 15U: B 9 teams, A 8 teams
- 16U: 4 teams
- 8 Jr Gold B, 2 Jr G A
- If under 4 teams will go to a different district
- PW AA and 10U A have asked to go to District 8
- District 8 10U A will have tournament later and so will try to have a small D2 10U A tournament
 - o 12U A did something similar so hoping this will work
- How often do team numbers fluctuate? team numbers do not typically fluctuate much from preliminary declarations, but sometimes do
 - biggest fluctuation would come if a WI pulled out
- Heavy work needs to be done in August
- There is some concern for 15U, losing kids to high school teams; level adjustment likely to happen, not a loss of teams, but MUST happen ASAP: answer should occur within 20 hours
- This has happened 6 years ago, when district declared B1, but should have been B2 team; team remained as B1 and several kids quit after

Tryout-Vice President Scott along with President Hopeman

- Ice time secured
- Ryan is heading up getting graders (biggest item)
- List to be distributed to get volunteers

Jersey Sub Committee-Director of Operations J.Brown

- Tryout jerseys will be coming here in a couple of days
- There were a ton of extra old ones so the new ones are a replica of the old ones
- Will change to a different tryout jersey next year
- Scrimmages during tryouts, need to have a temporary roster and need a paper scorebook
- When will we have codes for Gamesheets? Not sure
- Will load the iPads for updated grading criteria
- Tryout ice, we are not having Sunday tryouts, is there a reason? Small group made that decision, because of parent feedback that there are too many touches with tryouts; it is harder to get graders to come on the weekend
- For PW half the kids will only have 2 touches:
 - o this means we might only have 2 ice times to split 3 teams:
 - we do have ice time on Sunday, will need to discuss further to add another tryout date
- Motion for 1 additional tryout hour on Sunday for Peewees > Discuss
- Further discussion: least amount of ice time for tryouts is 3 hours, max 4 is hours
- Amend motion for Peewee and Bantams to have 1 more tryout > approval > pass
- Tryout doc that is online will get edited
- Are there 2 tryout sessions for PW? Yes, the groups will be sent out 9/19/2023
- Warm-ups of the cell phone policy, actual rule:
 - o no recording device in the locker room allowed;
 - o can have phone in locker room BUT CANNOT record > repercussions
- As an association where do we stand? Tricky because we don't own any of the rinks
- Can we collect phones in the locker room? Do not suggest, because there is a strong liability for loosing or breaking phones
- Should propose: do not use phones in the locker room
- Another proposal: do not bring phones in locker room
- At warmups was there an issue because there were no parents in the locker room? Yes, it happens all the time
- Can we put it in the code of conduct? With specific warning levels?
- USA Hockey does not have strong rules, so do not have a leg to stand on
- Can we have consequences for kids like No ice time for kid?
- Do not want to ruin kids' lives by a dumb mistake with phone recording in the locker room
- Are there other associations that do something?
- Teacher/Coach/Parent mentioned: it is our responsibility as parents and coaches to educate our children on expectations; it can be on the coach and the parent as we are in charge of the kids
- Motion for remainder of warm-ups and Tryouts or there will be a consequence you can use cell
 phone outside, but power off once you go in the locker room: approval 4 > opposed: 3> abstain
 0 > Motion Denied
- Will email parents to make phones not available in locker rooms in tryouts, and something else to come moving forward

Jerseys

- Squirts w/mite 4 will get new jerseys
- Older kids have the option to get a discounted new jersey (that are remaining), w/new number
- Discuss does RAYHA pay for all the new Squirt Jerseys?
 - What is the cost? ~47 kids; cost will be ~\$3100 for Squirts & mite 4

- We could not make a decision and scratch all the new jerseys
- o Make a motion for RAYHA to pay for the mite 4, unless sponsorship is possible
- Motion for Sponsor (Goodmanson Construction) to pay for squirt and mite 4 jerseys for this year: Approval > pass
- o Refunds will be needed for all squirt parents that have paid for Jersey
- o 8U team jersey is not included in fees, co-op could get a sponsorship if needed
- o 3rd jersey for any other team will need board approval

Ice Scheduler

- Ice time is VERY different from this year, RAYHA lost Saturdays to boys and girls HS teams
- OJ Ice looks different too: they chopped our time in 2 different time chunks instead of 1 chunk
- Peewee A and B1 and 12U A and B1 teams are going to 75 minutes for games, and they are only scheduled for 60 minutes, so the games need to get rescheduled
- How can we get a hold of the Ice Scheduler?
 - o Ice scheduler email address listed on RAYHA website
 - o Marauders will have an ice liaison for managers to feed to ice scheduler
- Some parents looked at ice time last year and it looked like some teams got more ice than others, but teams start with the same amount of ice time
 - Managers and coaches have the opportunity to get scrimmages with other teams at the other teams' ice times
 - Depending on how many scrimmages are set-up, it could look like a team got more ice time, because of the additional scrimmages that coaches and managers set-up
