## Illinois Hawks 2025-26 Contract

All parents/responsible adults will abide by all rules and regulations listed below.

- 1. Let the coaches coach!!
- 2. Parents/responsible parties are required to meet all financial obligations to the organization, including yearly dues, uniform fees, and other necessary costs. Agreeing to a spot on an Illinois Hawks Baseball or Softball team obligates you to the full posted or otherwise expressly agreed upon cost for the season. All fees are non-refundable unless expressly approved by the Illinois Hawks Board of Directors. Payment plans are for your convenience, and are installments on the full amount due. Any player non-compliant with this rule will be suspended from practice and play until their account is brought up to date. Payments or balances that are more than 30 days late without express approval from the Board of Directors will be subject to a finance charge until brought current. In the event that You have any outstanding amounts due to Illinois Hawks and Illinois Hawks pursues legal means of collection, You shall be responsible for any and all attorney fees, court costs, and other costs of collection, including any post-judgment attorney fees or litigation costs, that Illinois Hawks incurs in order to collect sums due by You. Families that choose to separate or are dismissed from their team due to violations of contract or team rules are still obligated to their full, agreed upon fees.
- **3.** Recognize the value and importance of volunteer and staff coaches alike. Give them their due respect. Without them, there would be no baseball or softball program.
- **4.** No parent or fan may possess illicit drugs at practices or any Hawks activity or games (home or away).
- 5. No parent or fan shall physically or verbally abuse parents, fans, coaches, players or umpires (including opponents).
- **6.** All parents and fans shall conduct themselves in a <u>sportsmanlike</u> manner. No yelling, booing, teasing, or cheering if another player is hurt. No profane or abusive language or unsportsmanlike gestures of any kind are tolerable.
- **7.** Any unlawful actions will be reported to the proper authorities, and are grounds for immediate dismissal from the program.
- 8. No parent shall interfere with practices, games, or **coaching** at any time. At no time is a parent to enter the practice or playing field unless specifically requested to do so by the team manager. Parents may observe, but should observe a 24 hour cooling period after games or practices to discuss any problems. (Please be sure to approach a coach.) Please keep in mind that playing time is at the discretion of the team manager.
  - Please notify the coach if your child will miss a practice or a game as far in advance as possible.
  - Please arrive in enough time that players are ready before the scheduled beginning of practice, and pick up your child at the designated end of practice.
  - Participation is NOT to be an excuse for unfinished homework help your child plan their time wisely.
- **9.** At least one parent or responsible adult must be in attendance at every game (you may designate your manager or another family with prior approval), or the child will not be allowed to participate in the game. (Developmental divisions only)

- **10. Uniforms** should only be worn at scheduled league games or as instructed by their manager.
- **11.** Hawks families are expected to support the Illinois Hawks and its projects, such as fundraising, community involvement, etc.
- **12.** Baseball and softball are active sports. I understand that injuries may occur, and that Illinois Hawks, its staff and coaches and related entities are not responsible or liable for injuries that may occur.

Any Parent or Other Non-Participating Family Member found to be in violation of any of the above will be handled in the following manner:

- **1.** A verbal and/or written warning will be given to the Family for the first violation.
- **2.** Second violation will result in a suspension from games/practices with player.
- **3.** Any repeat violations may result in a Family Suspension or Removal from the team with no refund.
