PAHA Live Streaming & Game Recording Policy

To support a positive, respectful environment for our players, families, and teams, PAHA allows live streaming and video recording of games, provided the following guidelines are followed.

General Guidelines

- Live streaming or recording games on platforms such as **Facebook Live, YouTube, or other media outlets** is permitted, but must be conducted in a **professional and respectful manner**.
- Individuals recording must be **mindful of their surroundings** and ensure equipment placement does not interfere with spectators, players, coaches, or officials.

Commentary and Conduct

- Any spoken or background commentary included in a stream or recording must be **positive, respectful, and sportsmanlike**.
- **Negative comments** toward players, coaches, referees, or opponents are not acceptable and may result in action by the association.
- If unsure, it is recommended to **mute or avoid live commentary** altogether to prevent accidental inappropriate remarks.

Use of Footage

- Game footage may be used for **team review, coaching, and player development** purposes.
- Publicly shared content should reflect the **values and integrity** of PAHA and youth sportsmanship.

Violations & Accountability

- Any concerns about live streams or recordings may be reviewed by PAHA.
- **Violations of this policy will be addressed in accordance with PAHA's Parent/Visitor Code of Conduct**, which may include a warning, loss of recording privileges, or other appropriate action.
