PAHA Financial Hardship Policy

PAHA is committed to ensuring all youth have the opportunity to participate in hockey, regardless of financial circumstances. Families experiencing financial hardship may submit a request for a **reduced registration fee**, following the guidelines below.

How to Request Assistance

- A **written request** must be submitted by a parent or guardian to the **PAHA Board** as early as possible. Contact: talaricotara@gmail.com
 - The request should include a brief explanation of the financial need and reason for requesting assistance.
 - All requests are handled **confidentially** and reviewed by the board.
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Important Guidelines

- **Requests must be submitted before registration is completed.**
This helps avoid the need for refunds or registrar corrections.
 - If approved, the reduction applies to the **current season only**.
 - Registration must wait until a decision has been communicated.
