## **How to Request Assistance**

- All requests are handled **confidentially** and reviewed by the board.

## **Important Guidelines**

- Requests must be submitted before registration is completed. This helps avoid the need for refunds or registrar corrections.
- If approved, the reduction applies to the **current season only**.
- Registration must wait until a decision has been communicated.
