Junior Crusaders Girls Hockey Program (JCGHP) is part of the Junior Crusaders Youth Hockey Association (JCYHA), a non-profit organization. We rely solely on volunteers and donations to keep fees as reasonable as possible. Ice costs, skill development sessions, and league fees run over \$750,000 each season, with each player responsible for an average of \$1,800 in personal expense. Fundraising and corporate sponsorship play an incredibly important role in helping to defray these costs. ### About our Jamboree:

We are committed to developing young female athletes and fostering a lifelong love of hockey. The 8U level of play is often the first level of organized hockey for a player. At this level, we focus on the **FUNDamentals** of movement and basic sport skills to create a foundation for future development. Girls hockey is among the fastest growing youth sports in the United States. While the number of girls teams has grown significantly, most of the girls' programs at the 8U level play in leagues that include mainly co-ed teams with a majority of all-boy rosters. It is not until the 10U or 12U level that most girl's programs play exclusively against all-girl teams. For many players and their families, **this Jamboree will be their first all-girls playing experience.** Our hope for this Jamboree is to create fun memories of laughter and friendships that will last well beyond their hockey days.
