Officer and Committee Reports:

1) Approval of Minutes from August 6, 2025:

MOTION to postpone the approval of the minutes from the August 6th meeting to the October Board meeting. Motion made by Carrie Valente and seconded by Josh Knapp. *Motion passes*

• Carrie requested the approval of the August 6th minutes be postponed since she did not send them out at least 24 hours prior to the meeting for review.

2) Vice President Report - Joshua Knapp

- Jerseys/Apparel
 - Oupdate on complaint responses: After reviewing received complaints about jersey sizes and fit out of 16, 4 appear to be too small. There was no consistency to the complaints, and Adrian, our JOG representative, asked if the club could guarantee that the sizes the parents ordered matched the sizes of the samples they tried on. Solution: JOG will allow club to reorder jerseys at the bulk pricing even though the quantity will be less. Players will be responsible for covering the cost of reordering and shipping except the following:
 - Hutchison(12U): JOG will cover the costs to replace the jersey due to misspelled name
 - Turner (HS): Club will cover the costs to replace the jersey due to incorrect size ordered

Josh will create a formal response to send to those who submitted complaints with instructions on how to order new jerseys.

- Jerseys for Picture Day: To make sure all players have a jersey to wear on picture day, managers will ask players to bring both sets of jerseys so players that need to borrow a jersey can for photos.
- Scorekeeping Training: Josh stated that the best way to learn Time to Score is in real time during a game; First by observing during one game then the next game have someone assist while the trainee operates Time to Score. Rebecca Kaser asked if a club wide training or seminar could take place to support new parents. 4)President Report-Lindsey Vasquez

- Fundraising-Ali Lovett shared a club wide fundraising idea to host a Skate-a-thon at Gateway or at United Skate (roller skating rink). If it is run similar to school Jog-a-thons where there are fun prizes or awards for reaching fundraising or team goals. Alli agreed to look into United Skates as a venue.
- Sponsorships update: currently have \$2000 in sponsorships earned by the club and a \$500.00 renewal from last season. More sponsors should be coming in before the 9/15 deadline. Lindsey requested a reminder to go out to Team Managers about the sponsorship deadline.
- Norcal Scholarship applications are open and due on October 12th. Scholarships will be awarded
 in December 2025. Application requires a letter of recommendation and volunteer verification,
 and requests need to be submitted to Carrie, Club Secretary by October 3rd.
- Locker Rooms-Travel. The board discussed ongoing issues and complaints in the travel team locker rooms. Josh will post locker room information and additional updates post board meeting updates in each team's crossbar chat.
 - Cell Phones- No one should be on their phones while in the locker room or any device that can take photos or record.
 - Parents in the locker room- besides 8u, Locker Room Monitors or Coaches should be the only adults in the locker room. A locker room monitor does not need to be present when two or more coaches are present. Quick Guide for adults in locker room:
 - 1 adult is present- they should stand near the propped door. So they can monitor behavior
 - If adults are in the locker room- need 2 adults present. Should never be 1 adult with kids.
 - Music Playlists in the locker room need to adhere to the USA Code of Conduct.
- Locker Rooms assignments on Saturdays and Sunday needed to be set due to multiple conflicts with the adult league. Saturdays, we only need 1 locker room and will typically use locker room #1. On Sundays- 8U House will use Locker room 1 starting at 8:00 am, and 10U-16U will use Locker rooms 2 and 3 starting at 9:15 am.

- Travel Schedule should be added over the next month: The schedule for the weekend of 9/20-21 will be released on 9/16. The October schedule will be available by September 30th and on October 10th the entire regular schedule will be released. High School will have preseason games in San Jose on 9/20 at 2:30 pm and 9/28 at 1:30 pm.
- Rink Schedule Conflicts: There have been some scheduling conflicts caused by Gateway with the
 adult league and Fresno State. The conflict with the adult league was fixed. Fresno State has
 posted a game day schedule that has several conflicts with game slots the club turned into
 Norcal. The rink has the club booked during those time slots.

- 5) Registrar-Lindsey Vasquez on behalf of Sarah Turner:
 - Rosters for all travel teams have all been uploaded on USA Hockey's portal and approved
- 6) In House Coordinator-Carrie Valente
 - House update
 - All Red Shirt Players attended the first House practice and they were reminded that they
 can attend 2 practices per week. Two parents asked if they could pay an additional fee,
 to attend an extra practice. Discussion was postponed to the board's GroupMe Chat due
 to the absence of 3 board members, including the Treasurer.
 - Partial House Season Offer/Fees: Jeff Ferguson would like to offer a prorated House league season, so those new players completing 3 months of Learn to Play can join.
 Carrie recommends both offering an 8-week partial season and a 4 week partial season.
 - Full House Session cost is \$550 for 12 weeks plus \$75.00 for jersey
 - Recommended cost for partial seasons:
 - 8 week will run from Sept 29-Nov 23, \$375 plus the \$75 jersey set
