NORTHERN COLORADO YOUTH HOCKEY PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Northern Colorado Youth Hockey (NCYH) players are expected to hold themselves to high moral standards emphasizing respect for individuals and for the spirit of the game. Players and parents understand that playing for NCYH is a privilege that requires commitment to upholding the values of the organization on and off the ice.

To remain in good standing, a player must:

- Show respect for facility personnel, coaches, fellow players, officials, and the league
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship before, during, and after games
- Respect the game, play fairly following its rules and regulations
- Refrain from abusive or offensive language, gestures, and music
- Respect the privilege of the use of the facilities
- Refrain from use of drugs, tobacco, nicotine, alcohol, and any other substances used inappropriately and/or illegally.

Bullying, Hazing, Sexual Harassments and Threats Policy:

NCYH is dedicated to promoting a positive, safe, and welcoming environment at all our games and events. We strive to build confidence, character, and a sense of community among our members. As defined in the Safe Sport Handbook, any efforts to undermine the positive environment through bullying, hazing, threats, or harassment will not be tolerated and may be subject to disciplinary action.

Substance Use Policy:

NCYH believes in the importance of maintaining a healthy environment for our players to train and compete. To that end, players are prohibited from possessing, using or consuming the following substances in all NCYH Facilities and at all NCYH Functions:

- Illegal drugs
- Marijuana and substances derived from marijuana
- Alcohol
- Tobacco
- Nicotine

Furthermore, vaping and the use or possession of similar products are expressly prohibited in all NCYH Facilities and at all NCYH functions under this policy.

Respect for Equipment and Facilities:

NCYH players will care for and respect the facilities and equipment made available during the season. Furthermore, NCYH players will commit to maintaining the cleanliness and condition of all facilities used for NCYH functions and activities including but not limited to:

- NoCo Ice Center
- Epic Ice (Fedora Pool and Ice)
- Other Ice Rinks & Locker Rooms
- Hotels
- Restaurants
- Any other location visited for NCYH Functions

Discipline:

NCYH is committed to fostering a healthy, safe and positive environment for our players, coaches, and families. Players that fail to follow the code of conduct as outlined in this document shall be subject to discipline which may include, but are not limited to reduced ice time, sitting out games, suspension from team activities, and dismissal from the association.

Discipline shall be handled by the Team Managers, Hockey Director, Assistant Director and as outlined in the applicable NCYH Bylaws, Policies and Procedures.

Commitment to Excellence:

As a player with the Northern Colorado Youth Hockey Association, I will conduct myself in accordance with this code of conduct. Further, I understand that violation of this code of conduct or any violation of Federal, state, or local laws and/or ordinances will result in disciplinary action that could result in suspension or immediate dismissal from the association and forfeiture of all fees.
